JOB DESCRIPTION**Summary/Objective**

The Senior Architect position is primarily responsible for reviewing design deliverables (drawings and specifications) relating to pre-owned automobile dealerships, collision centers, auction facilities and parts stores for a major US automobile retailer. The design deliverables are prepared by outside architectural firms and material/equipment vendors. The reviews are phased throughout design development to assure that the design documents are complete and accurate, and conform to pertinent client requirements, including corporate branding guidelines. The Senior Architect also prepares conceptual site and building layout drawings to support land acquisition and budgeting.

Essential Functions

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

1. Review design deliverables (plans and specifications) prepared by architectural firms and provide comments relative to completeness of design documents, conformance with client requirements, adherence to building codes and proper design practice.
2. Coordinate with client regarding operational and corporate branding requirements.
3. Lead the development of design standards/guidelines and building prototype designs for pre-owned, collision, auction and parts facilities.
4. Manage collection and filing of design documentation to assure that it is current and available for efficient retrieval.
5. Prepare conceptual site and building layout drawings to support land acquisition and budgeting processes.
6. Review contractor and vendor submittals, including product sheets, shop drawings, samples, record drawings, etc.
