After reviewing the 2-year Interim Progress Program Report (IPR) submitted by University of Notre Dame School of Architecture, the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) has concluded that the program has demonstrated progress toward addressing deficiencies identified in the most recent Visiting Team Report.

In addition to the mandatory information required by the 5-year IPR in 2021, the report must also demonstrate progress toward meeting deficiencies in Condition I.1.3 Social Equity, and as there were three Not Met SPC within Realm B, the fifth-year report must include student work examples as evidence of progress toward meeting deficiencies in the following SPC: B.1 Pre-Design, B.4 Technical Documentation, and B.6 Environmental Systems, in both the B. Arch. and M. Arch. programs. Please note that Statistical Reports are still due annually.
