## About the Data

The Graduate Outcomes Report provides insight into the initial career paths of graduate students after completing their programs at Notre Dame. The School of Architecture collects information directly through a Graduate Exit Survey in May each year. This report includes data from the last 11 years (academic years 2022-23, 2021-22, 2020-21, 2019-20, 2018-19, 2017-18, 2016-17, 2015-16, 2014-15, 2013-14, and 2012-13). Unless otherwise noted, years are combined. In order to protect graduates' identities, data is omitted when the count is fewer than 5.

The data in this report includes the Graduate Outcomes for the School of Architecture. This report includes data for the following programs: Master of Architectural Design & Urbanism (MADU) 2-year post-professional degree, Master of Architecture (M.Arch) 2-year professional degree, Master of Architecture (M.Arch) 3-year professional degree, and the Master of Science in Historic Preservation (MSHP) degree.



## Knowledge Rate

Over the last 11 years, the School of Architecture has had a knowledge rate of 94.5%. Data is collected through surveys, LinkedIn research, and internal communication with each program to obtain the most accurate information about post-graduation plans.

## Post-Graduation Status

Below is the post-graduation status for the School of Architecture over the last 11 years. “Employed-academia” includes academic positions that are tenure-track, research, or teaching faculty at higher education institutions. “Employment - in the discipline or allied disciplines” includes employment in the architecture discipline or allied disciplines such as urban design, landscape architecture, interior design, planning, etc. and includes design firms, non-profits, startups, and other related employment. “Other” outcomes include graduates engaging in paid work, volunteer work, freelance work, internships, etc. that are outside the discipline of architecture or allied disciplines. Students with unknown status are excluded in the calculations below.
