 Las Catalinas in Costa Rica deploys for the first time generative principles for
- A one-day <u>Open Seminar</u> in London outlines the theory of armatures to a conference of professionals at the Princes' Foundation.
- The urban plan for the reconstruction of a bazaar and the Shi'a neighborhood in central Kabul is the first modern infill that re-deploys traditional construction methods practices developed by the *Turquoise Mountain Foundation*.
- 2000-3 Pro-Urb Listserv writing accompanies a critical period of New Urbanist expansion. Some debates are published in The <u>NUP Series</u>, and the writing helps to consolidate pre-transect NU theory.
- The first modern boulevard in the US, in Kentlands. is re-constituted according to it's original geometric design to achieve traffic calming.
