## **NOTES:**

- All undergraduate students at the University of Notre Dame are subject to the Core Curriculum. For more information, visit <a href="https://corecurriculum.nd.edu/">https://corecurriculum.nd.edu/</a>.
- The School of Architecture requires six credit hours in Italian language before Rome. The Department of Romance Languages offers a single-semester option for six credit hours (ROIT 10110) or a two-semester option of courses carrying four credit hours each (ROIT 10101 & 10102). Many students prefer the two-semester format. The two extra credit hours completed in the two-semester format count toward total elective credits. Students may continue their study of Intermediate Italian in Rome.
- Courses in Calculus or Physics strengthen preparation for the required structures courses. Courses in environmental issues are often pertinent to architecture and may contribute to a Sustainability Minor.
- The four required courses in Architectural History do not fulfill the University Core Curriculum History requirement, but do fulfill the Liberal Arts 4: Art & Literature or Advanced Language & Culture requirement.
- From the group of History or Social Science or Integration course requirements, students must take two of the three subjects. E.g. an Architecture student with a History minor can count only one History course toward the Core Curriculum, and must take either Social Science or an Integration course.
- The School of Architecture offers three optional concentrations: Furniture Design, Historic Preservation/Restoration, and Architectural Practice and Enterprise.
  Requirements for each of the concentrations are outlined on the following pages.

## Required Courses for the Architectural Practice & Enterprise Concentration:

The concentration in Architectural Practice & Enterprise consists of four courses within the Mendoza College of Business (<a href="http://mendoza.nd.edu/">http://mendoza.nd.edu/</a>) to be taken one per semester during your fourth and fifth years.

The following two courses are **required** for all students who choose the APE concentration:
